REPORT TO THE ANNUAL PARISH MEETING - MAY 2021

Most of the Trust's income derives from its investments. Following the advice of its independent financial adviser and the objectives laid down in the Investment Policy Statement the Trust moved its portfolio to Brooks MacDonald in order to invest only in ethical funds. Despite the financial disarray caused by the global pandemic, the Trust has again managed its funds successfully. The Trust was unable to hold its regular May or November meetings in 2020 but all issues were covered by group emails.

During the past twelve months just over £7,400 has been distributed to residents covering personal grants, assistance with heating costs, academic and education, family and transport grants. A grant was also made to Bacton Under Fives nursery to help them continue running during the pandemic.
