| Civil Parking Enforcement | Parking enforcement transfers from the Police to local councils from 6 th April. The launch publicity is around the mantra of "Look for lines, Check for signs, Avoid the fines." Enforcement within Mid Suffolk will be managed by West Suffolk DC. If you are parking in Stowmarket or Eye just be aware that there will be a much tighter regime than that in place previously.
